RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. The Tournament is open to club and social players only. Players in the professional circuit are not allowed to enter.
2. Seeding and determination of players if required will be at the sole discretion of the Tournament Organizers i.e. players from other clubs with no known playing history will be included in the Open Men Class.
3. Players are assured of a minimum 2 sets play.
4. The schedule of matches will be advised to all players if contact numbers are provided otherwise it is the responsibility of the player/players to contact the Tournament organizers. The Tournament Organizers reserves the right to make changes to the schedule. Change of schedule will not be made at the request of players.
5. Players on a group of 3 will play a single round robin. The pair with the highest number of sets won or in case of tie – the number of games won will advance to the next round. Pairs on a group of 2 will play a best of 2 sets with a tie break if scores are at one set all.
6. The order of play will be posted on the bulletin board. Participants must find out the time of their matches and must be ready to play within 5 minutes before their scheduled time. Defaulting time is 15 minutes. Once a decision is made on the default – no appeal will be accepted.
7. Players are required to inform the Tournament organizers or present themselves at the control desk upon arrival.
8. Umpires may be provided for the Finals
9. The Philippine Australia Sports and Culture Inc and the Tournament Organizers will not be responsible for any fatal, personal injuries or loss or any mishaps caused to any player during this tournament.
10. The awarding of all winners and runner-ups will take place during the PASC Sports awards on 29 August 2010. Details to be given after the tournament.
11. **On-site alternates:** Players who missed the entry deadline may appear at the tournament site at their own risk to fill a no-show vacancy, provided such players would not upset the seeding or play schedule. The acceptance of the on-site alternate is at the discretion of the tournament organizers.
